4. The purpose of this hearing will be to consider the Determinations in the Municipal Services Review (MSR) for the City of Wasco.
5. A Notice of Exemption has been prepared and is being considered for this MSR.

7. The general description of the territory concerned is as follows:

The geographical area covered in the City of Wasco's MSR encompasses the area located in northwest Kern County along State Route 46, occupies approximately 5,466 acres or 8.54 square miles. Bakersfield, the largest city in Kern County, is 25 miles southwest, and the closest incorporated city is Shafter, which is 8 miles south. Lying within one of the most diverse and productive farming areas in the world, Wasco is relatively flat with an elevation approximately 330 feet above mean sea level. The Sierra Nevada foothills are located to the east, the Tehachapi transverse range is to the south, and the Temblor range is to the west. The primary waterways in the vicinity are the Friant-Kern Canal 5 miles to the east of Wasco, Poso Creek 3.5 miles north of Wasco and the California Aqueduct 15 miles to the west of Wasco.
